





Since December 2012, the Princess Charlene of Monaco Foundation saves lives by fighting against drowning and develops the education of children through the values of sport.

DROWNING



Drowning is the **3rd leading** cause of unintentional injury death worldwide, claiming around **300 000** lives by drowning each year.

Children **aged under 5 years** account for nearly a quarter of all drowning deaths.

Drowning is the **fourth leading** cause of death for children **aged 1–4 years** and the **third leading** cause of death for children **aged 5–14 years**.

92 percent of drowning deaths occur in **low- and middle-income countries**.

The World Health Organization has classified the following sites as the most dangerous. The risk of drowning may increase during activities which place people in close proximity to water without appropriate safeguarding.




